PROPER PROCUDURE TO REQUEST A VIDEO HEARING DURING COVID-19

- 1. Any request must be made in the form of a *Joint Motion for In Camera Request* for *Video Hearing* signed by all counsel of record.
- 2. All Joint Motions shall contain a certification by all counsel:
- that all parties and counsel agree to a hearing being conducted by video means;
- that all parties, counsel and witnesses have the technical ability to participate in the requested video hearing;
- that all parties, counsel and witnesses have the ability to participate in conformance with all CDC guidelines related to the Covid-19 Pandemic;
- that any and all exhibits to be introduced have been stipulated to by all counsel and parties;
- that if any witness/witnesses are to be sequestered, when in such is "called" to testify, he/she will be available immediately without delay;
- of an estimated amount of time required for the hearing; and
- of which video conferencing platform will be used.
- 3. All stipulated exhibits shall be duly marked, indexed and filed with the Clerk of the Court at least thirty-six (36) hours before the scheduled start of the video hearing with a written stipulation signed by all counsel of record. Furthermore, the parties shall submit a stipulated witness list within the same time frame
- 4. Upon the Court's review of any *Joint Motion for In Camera Request for Video Hearing* an order will be entered either approving or denying the request.
- 5. Any approval by the Court will set forth the scheduled date and time for the requested hearing.
- 6. The attorneys shall be responsible for initiating the video conference and calling into the Court.
